

Schengen visa for the spouse/parent/child of an EU/EEA citizen (Non-German)

General Information

- The visa application can be submitted at the earliest six months prior to the planned trip.
- Documents that are not issued in German or English must be submitted together with a translation.
- Each visa application is reviewed individually. The German missions reserve the right to request further documentation.
- Submission of an incomplete application may lead to a refusal of your visa application.
