The German Consulate General in Los Angeles is looking to fill the full-time position (40 hours weekly) of:

Driver (m/f/d) by mid-September 2026

The position entails the following responsibilities and duties:

- Daily pick-up and drop-off of the Consul General at their Residence
- Driving the Consul General and other staff members to official events in the consular district, including after regular work hours and/or on weekends with overnight stays being a possibility
- Upkeep, cleaning, and refueling of two vehicles
- Organizing maintenance or repair appointments for the two official vehicles
- Minor office tasks (e.g. mail runs)

Salary and Benefits:

The Consulate General offers a competitive salary (starting at USD 4,473.00 per month with annual raises in the first five years), health insurance (starting one month after hiring) and a 401(k) plan (after the probationary period of six months).

We also offer 17 paid vacation days per year (which will increase to up to 28 days depending on years of employment with the Consulate General), 13 paid sick days and 13 paid German/American national holidays.

Overtime will be compensated for.

The Consulate General is looking for a conscientious and experienced individual who is keen on working for Germany and being a part of a dynamic and internationally oriented team.
